It has now also become the standard for ecotourism and nature tour operators in North America. Several modifications have been made to our standard Habitat model shelter based on direct input from park guests. The result is a special design offering greater comfort for those desiring a more luxurious wilderness camping experience.





Design Shelter's "Parks" model Habitat offers overnight park guests additional creature comforts typically not found in traditional tents. Not only do they experience the comfort and convenience of a full sized structurally sound soft walled portable shelter – they get to enjoy these added benefits...



- Extra high 193 cm (78") vertical sidewalls for spacious headroom
- Extra wide 72 cm (32") full size hinged and latched lockable door (wheelchair accessible)
- Superior sized 102 cm (40") wide by 81 cm (32") tall three layer window design to enjoy nature's daytime beauty. Layers include removable bug screen (with noseeum screen option), clear vinyl window and privacy flap
- Roof eave overhang and individual window eave overhangs help prevent water seepage in these areas
- An optional insulated cover provides park operators with a year round revenue stream

Further, each shelter is typically supplied with two bunk beds to accommodate 4 people, a table, shelves and 4 chairs. Park guests get to enjoy all of the benefits of a traditional camping experience - the sights, smells and sounds - but do so in the relative luxury and comfort of a Parks model Habitat shelter.
